## **Medication Optimisation Clinical reviews including:**

- NSAID reviews Coxibs and Diclofenac only
- S.T.O.M.P (Medication reviews of pts with Learning Difficulties)
- Care Home patient medication reviews by Care Home Pharmacist

## Other projects include:

- Review of patients using 'Antimuscarinics' for possible 'drug holiday' as long term use has detrimental side effects on mental health.
- Repatriation of specialist drugs of where prescribing should remain with the consultant.
- Highlight prescribing of Perindopril 'Arginine' and 'Dosulepin' which are drugs not advised by NHS England to be routinely prescribed in Primary Care.

## Issuing of steroid treatment cards

Patients prescribed oral corticosteroids for a course of greater than 3 weeks in duration should be issued with a steroid treatment card by the prescriber. This also applies to those patients who have more than 4 short courses of oral corticosteroids in one year.

Prescribers also need to be aware that steroid cards are recommended for patients having regular high dose inhaled corticosteroids as per the following table:

## **Managed Repeats**

Please read carefully the information below for an update on the withdrawal of managed repeat process;

**Phased Start** – Please be reminded, it is expected that there will be a cross-over period of approximately two months to allow patients to make alternative arrangements and to agree (between prescriber and dispenser) necessary provisions for those vulnerable/high-risk patients. To assist patients with this transition please use leniency before refusing to request or issue medications during this changeover.

Patient Queries – We have been receiving numerous patient queries throughout the last week and aim to deal with these as quickly as possible. We have noticed that many of these queries could have been dealt with by referring to our patient leaflet or Q&A sheet – please can you ensure you have access to these patient resources when discussing changes with any patients. This is to ensure a consistent message is being provided and patients are not unnecessarily searching for information. Access to additional patient information can be obtained by contacting the Meds Opt Team.

**Patient Leaflets** – these have been distributed to all GP Practices and Pharmacies for patient use, please hand out as needed. If you require any further supplies please contact the Meds Opt Team.

#### Stock Issues

- Bezalip 200mg Tablets Prescribe as generic Bezafibrate
- Doxazosin XL Tablets Prescribe the standard release preparations
- EpiPen 300mcg Limited to TWO injectors per prescription
- Adalat LA 20mg, 30mg and 60mg PR Tablets Not expected to be available till 2021, supplies of other Nifedipine Capsules and Tablets remain available currently including, Adipine, Coracten, Nifedipress and Tensipine.
- Bumetanide 5mg Tablets Prescribe either 1mg Tablets or 1mg/5ml Oral Solution
- Carbagen 200mg IR, 400mg IR, 200mg MR and 400mg MR Tablets switched to Tegretol
- Labetolol Tablets and Metoprolol 50mg and 100mg Tablets
- Sinemet stock supplies have now been resolved, however the product now has a new appearance, see attached document.

#### **OTC Vitamin B12**

As per new B12 guidance, in many cases patients will be directed to buy Vitamin B12 OTC. The following table details availability and prices.
